AKAL PARTNERS WITH LOCAL COMPANY FOR FIRST MOVE INTO AFRICA

Akal Security has won its first contract in Africa with a winning bid to provide security to the U.S. Embassy in Freetown, Sierra Leone. Akal is providing the guard services under a joint venture partnership with Sierra Leone-based Security Support Group international, said Akal International Division Director, Chuck Raderstorf.

The contract is worth \$4 million to \$5 million over five years and will involve hiring about 145 guards and one or two support staff in addition to the project manager.

All of the staff except the project manager will be hired locally for an official start date of November 1, 2007.

This is Akal's first contract with a U.S. Embassy. We were able to provide a quality technical solution and very competitive price proposal because of the joint partnership with a local firm.

Akal will provide access control, personnel and vehicle screening, mobile patrols, and surveillance detection for several embassy locations in Freetown on the western coast of Africa.

Akal has hired Brad Owens, a former intelligence analyst for the military with experience in West Africa and the Middle East, specifically for the Sierra Leone project. The country is economically depressed and only recently stabilized, emerging from an 11-year civil war in 2002. However, Sierra Leone held free elections in early August and is receiving social and economic support from the United States and other countries. The future is very promising, said Raderstorf.
