AKAL FLYING HIGH WITH JPATS

Akal officers will take to the skies under a new contract with the federal Justice Prisoner and Alien Transportation System.

Akal Security will provide air security officers for the air fleet of the U.S. Marshals Service and the Bureau of Immigration and Customs Enforcement under a contract worth up to \$36.7 million over five years.

Rick Durham, Homeland Security Division director, said Akal Security's "exceptional management and business model" was instrumental in Akal winning the contract, along with the company's proven performance and accountability.

A little over 100 Akal officers will provide security on flights out of Alexandria, Louisiana; La Mesa, Arizona; and Agua Dilla, Puerto Rico, Durham said. Each flight will have 14 or 15 officers, with at least two women officers, he said.

The Justice Prisoner and Alien Transportation System transports detainees in the custody of the Federal Bureau of Prisons, the military, federal law enforcement agencies and Immigration and Customs Enforcement, including aliens being deported outside of the United States. The only government-run regularly scheduled passenger airline. JPATS is one of the largest transporters of prisoners in the world, with more than 1,000 requests a day to move prisoners between judicial districts, correctional facilities, and foreign countries.
